Help contribute to the understanding of frontotemporal dementia (FTD) and Alzheimer's disease (AD)

Researchers at Northwestern University are currently evaluating the use of a new behavioral test to differentiate between early/mild FTD and AD, potentially leading to earlier, accurate diagnoses and more effective treatment plans.

Participation Includes:

- Completing two simple behavioral tasks at the CNADC clinic located on the 20th floor of the Galter Pavilion at Northwestern Memorial Hospital

Initial Inclusion Criteria:

- A diagnosis of early/mild behavioral variant of FTD or early/mild Alzheimer's disease
- Between 45 and 85 years of age
