Kathryn Aring Piper Center for Frontotemporal Cognitive Disorders

Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine invites applications and nominations for the position of Director of the Kathryn Aring Piper Center for Frontotemporal Cognitive Disorders. The new Director will report to the Dean of the medical school. In this role, the Director is responsible for oversight of the academic, research, and clinical affairs of the Center.

The endowed Piper Center is part of the Mesulam Institute for Cognitive Neurology and Alzheimer's Disease. The institute is home to over 23

primary faculty and 73 member faculty who are engaged in leading edge basic, translational and clinical research supported by approximately \$47 million of annual research funding. Some faculty also provide patient care across a broad range of conditions through our Memory Clinic at Northwestern Medicine and all are dedicated to training future leaders in the field.

The Feinberg School of Medicine currently is supported by approximately \$700 million of annual research funding.

Successful candidates will possess an MD or MD/PhD with board certification in Neurology or Psychiatry and be eligible for a faculty appointment as a full-time associate professor or professor with proven clinical skills, scholarly accomplishments and national recognition in a science or clinical discipline.
